



GUEST POLICY

The Butler Creek Health Education Center offers lifestyle seminars to help individuals change their health habits. We rely on diet, exercise, simple remedies, and prayer. We are not a medical facility, nor do we have a medical staff; we are a missionary facility staffed with individuals dedicated to serving the Lord through health ministry.

ENVIRONMENT

The Butler Creek Health Education Center strives to maintain a distraction free environment for staff, students, and lifestyle guests; a peaceful environment is good for healing of the mind and soul. We welcome our lifestyle guests into our home environment, and ask that they observe Christian courtesy and deportment while residents in our program.

Occasionally a guest will not see the benefit in our peaceful home environment; for those individuals we grant a three (3) day furlough to recommit and reconsider the advantages that our program offers. Guests may choose to stay at a hotel in Florence, AL or make some other arrangements for lodging and food. The guest is responsible for all costs associated with the furlough. If, after returning to the program they aren't able to abide by our policies a longer furlough may be granted.

DRESS CODE

We advise our guests to bring casual outfits for maximum comfort (including good footwear for outside, at least 2 pairs). At the same time, we request that our guests avoid wearing tank tops, mini shorts, or similar articles of clothing.

DRUG & ALCOHOL FREE

Butler Creek is a drug, alcohol and tobacco-free facility; a cleaning fee of \$250 will be charged if a guest smokes in his/her room.

MINIMUM DISTRACTION ATMOSPHERE – WIFI FREE ZONE

In order to maintain a distraction free environment, we request that guests not bring music, DVD's, movies, laptops, or other media/electronic devices to the program. They may bring their phone. We provide a variety of nature videos and educational documentaries for our guests. All guests have access to land line telephones.

Guest on Addiction Recovery or Mental Health Wellness Program are not allowed to have their cellphones or any other media/electronic devices.

QUIET TIME

Butler Creek observes quiet time from 9:00 PM until 6:00 AM. This gives our guests an opportunity to enjoy a restful night of sleep and to wake up refreshed for the new day.

FOLLOW-UP

After the completing the program, a guest may wish to remain as a volunteer assisting in the ministry at Butler Creek.

REFUND POLICY

If a guest chooses to withdraw from the program, no refunds will be given; however, a credit of days will be available and must be used within one year.
